County Convention Rules

1. The latest edition Robert's Rules of Order shall govern in all instances in which they are not inconsistent with the North Carolina Republican Party Plan of Organization.

2. Convention Rules may be amended or suspended only by a two-thirds vote of the delegates present on the floor of the Convention. Delegates shall be considered on the floor of the Convention if they are in the Convention hall.

3. Upon the adoption of the Credentials Committee Report and these Rules, all Delegates will be deemed to have attended their respective Precinct Meetings and to have been duly elected to attend the County Convention from that precinct.

4. Voting shall be by show of hands. There shall be no proxy or absentee voting. Delegates must be on the floor of the Convention at the time such vote is taken. Delegates shall be considered on the floor of the Convention if they are in the Convention hall.

5. Delegates desiring to be heard on any matter shall notify the Convention Chair prior to the convening of the Convention. Any delegate addressing the convention shall state his or her name and the name of the precinct in which he or she resides. No delegate may speak for more than five minutes on any matter of business before the Convention.

6. Before any Resolution can be proposed to the Convention, it must be submitted to the Convention Chair in writing prior to the convening of the Convention.

8. A quorum necessary for the transaction of business shall be fifty percent plus one of the delegates present at the Convention as certified by the Credentials Committee.

9. The Convention shall be conducted in a manner and spirit of courtesy and respect that dignifies the Republican Party.

10. Upon the conclusion of the business as set out in the Agenda, the Convention Chair shall adjourn the Convention.
